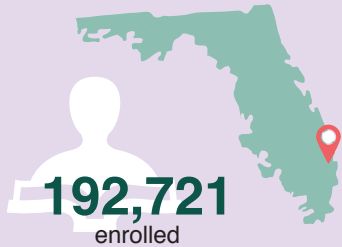
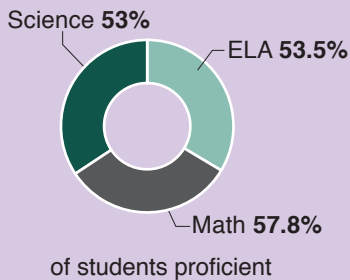
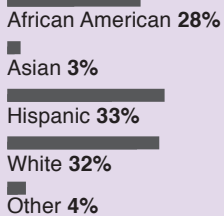

## Project Overview

The School District of Palm Beach County is converting five traditional schools into whole-school magnet programs that offer high-caliber, rigorous curricula, and innovative instruction. Driven by students' interests, the magnet programs strengthen students' knowledge of academic subjects and provides them with the skills necessary to improve their achievement. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project will reduce minority group isolation and increase socioeconomic integration; promote systemic reform aligned with challenging state content standards and student performance standards; develop and design innovative educational methods and practices that promote diversity; provide professional development that enhances and sustains high performance; and provide equitable access to high-quality educational programs that enable students to succeed academically.

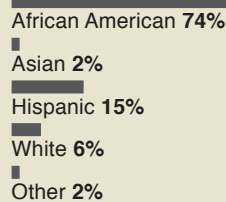
